Oxford, Miss.- The UIC offense managed only two hits against Rebel pitching, and a strong effort from freshman starter [Don Phillis](#) went for naught in the Flames' 5-0 loss to No. 18 Ole Miss in the series finale at Oxford-University Stadium on Sunday.

UIC (3-7) could only muster two hits off of Ole Miss starter Lance Lynn (1-0) and reliever Garrett White, who was credited with a save.

Phillis was perfect through three innings, but the Rebels got on the board in the fifth on Justin Brashear's sacrifice fly RBI to make the score 1-0.

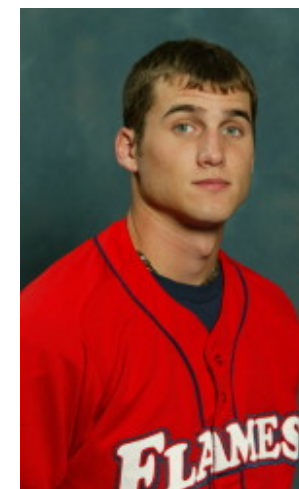
With two out in the sixth, Zack Cozart connected on a two-run homer to extend the Ole Miss lead to 3-0.
