

## Men's Basketball Gets Past Eastern Washington, 67-52

Armond Williams paces UIC with 19 points in the Gazette Hawkeye Challenge consolation win.

**Iowa City, Iowa -** The UIC men's basketball team bounced back from a tough loss last night in the opening round of the Gazette Hawkeye Challenge, posting a 67-52 victory over Eastern Washington on Saturday in the consolation game at Carver-Hawkeye Arena.

Senior forward <u>Armond Williams</u> led three Flames (7-2) in double figures with 19 points, while also adding five rebounds. <u>Cedrick Banks</u> chipped in with 13 points while senior <u>Martell Bailey</u> fell just shy of his first double-double of the season, finishing with 11 points and nine assists.

Sophomore <u>Justin Bowen</u> also had a strong game for UIC, tallying career bests of six points and four rebounds in 14 minutes off the bench.

Alvin Snow paced the Eagles (2-5) with a game-high 21 points.

The Flames trailed 36-34 with just over 14 minutes remaining in the contest, but a 17-4 UIC run over the next four minutes gave them an 11-point lead they would never relinquish. Bailey keyed the surge with eight points and three assists.
