No. 2 UIC Advances To Semifinal Match Against No. 3 Cleveland State On Saturday

The Flames were led by Amanda Kenny with 16 kills and 12 digs versus Butler

Dayton, Ohio - UIC advances to the 2006 Horizon League semifinals with a sweep over Butler (30-20, 30-22, 30-14) on Friday afternoon. With the win, the Flames face off against No. 3 Cleveland State on Saturday, Nov. 18 at 1:30 p.m. Central. The Vikings swept No. 6 Loyola in the first match of the tournament this morning.

Junior [Amanda Kenny](#) guided the Flames with 16 kills and 12 digs. Junior [Katarina Nedeljko](#) notched 14 kills and nine digs, while senior [Ambria Springer](#) paced the Flames at the net with six blocks. Senior [Katie Kozak](#) totaled six kills and a team-high .545 attack percentage.

UIC dominated defensively, holding Butler to .050 attack percentage in game one. The Flames posted a 5-1 run early for a 9-4 lead. The Bulldogs knotted it at 12-12, but the Flames sparked another run (14-5) to take an 11-point advantage. Butler posted four straight points, but UIC ended the momentum on a kill by Kenny. The Flames sealed the victory (30-20) on Kenny's fifth kill of game one.

UIC's domination continued in game two, jumping out to a 7-2 start. Butler inched its way back to get within one point (11-10), but the Flames turned on the heat, notching five unanswered points. UIC took a 2-0 lead with a 30-22 win in game two.

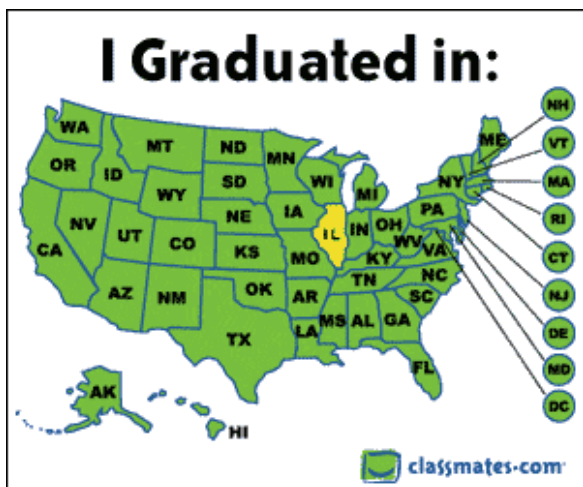


Senior Ambria Springer paced the Flames at the net with a team-high six
