**Green Bay, Wis.-** The University of Illinois at Chicago women's tennis team returned to action on Friday after nearly a week and a half off, but they didn't miss a beat in their 6-1 win over Detroit in Green Bay, Wis.

The match was part of a three-team Horizon League battle that included Wisconsin-Green Bay, who also defeated the Titans by a 6-1 count earlier in the day.

UIC (9-6, 4-0 Horizon League) continued their conference dominance with a superb overall effort, spearheaded by a doubles sweep and wins in the top five spots.

[Beatriz Cabrera](#) led the charge with a 6-0, 6-0 singles sweep of Bianca Savarino in the lead slot, and it was all downhill for Detroit after that. Cabrera, [Ayca Gumuscu](#), [Iris Jaklin](#), [Corey Steven](#) and [Melanie Humphrey](#) combined to go 30-3 in first set play and 30-2 in final set action.

The Flames were equally dominant in doubles, sweeping the three matches 8-3, 8-2 and 8-2.
