Flames take top honors in the women's 200-meter dash and the men's triple jump.

West Lafayette, Ind. - UIC kicked off the 2007 indoor track and field season on Saturday afternoon by competing in the Purdue Invitational at Lambert Fieldhouse.

The women's team was paced by senior [Rowsha LaBranche](#), who finished first in the 200-meter dash with a time of 27.41 while taking third in the 400-meter race (1:01.39).

The men's squad's day was highlighted by the triple jump where rookie [Andy Wall](#) and senior [Jeff Simpson](#) took first and second with Wall leaping 12.33m and Simpson a personal-best 12.17m.
