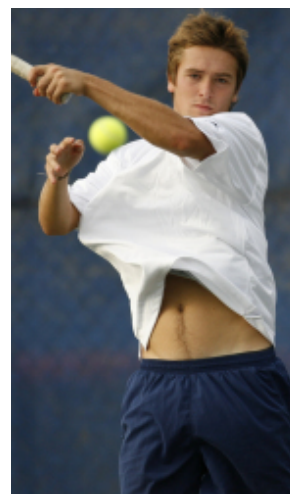
The Flames could not create any momentum against the Vikings in doubles play, with CSU picking up 8-2 victories at the first and third slots.
