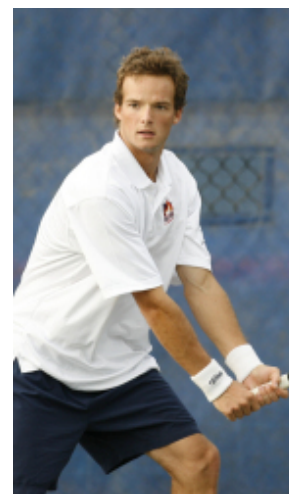
Junior [Adriano Liccardo](#) performed well for the second straight weekend, pushing his opponent to a tiebreaker in the first set, but was defeated in the following set.
