#### NO RUST FOR FLAMES:

After a seven-week break from dual meet competition, the University of Illinois at Chicago men's and women's swimming and diving teams showed no signs of rust in handily defeating Valparaiso's men's and women's teams. The UIC men took a 140-61 win, while the Flames women grabbed a 135-95 victory. UIC took 19 of the first 20 events, including 18 straight wins, before running the last six events as exhibition.

#### DOUBLE-WHAMMY:

The UIC swimming and diving team received great news on Tuesday after a dominating performance over Valpo, as the Horizon League named **Blake Booher (Barrington, Ill./Barrington H.S.)** and **Colleen Dougherty (Woodstock, Ill./Woodstock H.S.)** the Horizon League Swimming & Diving Athletes of the Week for the period ending January 10th.

#### BLAKE SPEEDS TOWARD RECORD:

Sophomore **Blake Booher** continued his journey to smash the UIC school record in the 50-yard freestyle, as the second-year freestyle sprinter posted a career-best 20.82 against Valpo. It marked the second time this season that Booher posted a sub-21 second time in the event after swimming a 20.86 earlier in the year. He currently leads the Horizon League in the 50 free.

#### KROES THE DISTANCE:

Senior **Brian Kroes (Hoffman Estates, Ill./Conant H.S./Northern Illinois)** had a fine meet for UIC on Saturday, winning the 500 and 1,000 freestyle events.

#### 100 FREE IS COLLEEN'S STYLE:

It's been a stellar start to the career of freshman **Colleen Dougherty**. Dougherty chalked up her fifth win in six attempts in the 100-yard freestyle this Saturday, winning in 54.55. Dougherty has yet to finish lower than second in the event and leads the Flames with a top time of 54.23 in the 100 free.

#### SEGOVIA TURNS IN SEASON BESTS:

Senior **Vanessa Segovia (Brookfield, Ill./Trinity H.S.)** turned in season-best performances this past Saturday, putting up a 5:17.56 in the 500 free and a 2:15.83 in the 200 IM.

#### WOMEN TRAVEL TO NORMAL:

The Flames resume action on Friday when the women's team travels to Normal, Ill., to take on Illinois State at 5 p.m.

#### FINAL HOME MEET OF 2005:

UIC caps off the home schedule this Saturday as the Flames take on Horizon League rival UW-Green Bay at the UIC Natatorium beginning with diving at 12:30 p.m. The Flames will honor 10 of their own as part of Senior Day festivities.
