### Men's Swimming Signs Three To National Letters Of Intent

Head Coach Paul Moniak inks two sprint freestylers, backstroke specialist to swim for Flames beginning in 2006-07.

**Chicago, Ill.-** University of Illinois at Chicago Head Coach [Paul Moniak](#) announced on Friday morning that Andrew Peterson (Morton Grove, Ill./Niles North H.S.), Brenden Dougherty (Woodstock, Ill./Woodstock H.S.), and Cameron Seebeck (Eden Prairie, Minn./Eden Prairie H.S.) have signed National Letters of Intent to swim for the Flames beginning in the 2006-07 campaign.

Peterson trains with the Leaning Tower YMCA club team, where he was a YMCA National Qualifier. His best times include a 1:01.26 in the 100-meter backstroke and a 2:12.50 in the 200-meter backstroke.

"Andrew is a backstroker who has vastly improved in the last year and has tremendous potential," said Moniak.

Dougherty, the brother of current UIC women's swimming team member [Colleen Dougherty](#), made a strong impact at last year's IHSA State Championships with a 10th-place showing in the 100-yard freestyle and a 15th-place finish in the 50-yard freestyle. In both events he set career-bests as a junior with a 21.87 in the 50 free and a 47.71 in the 100 free. Dougherty also swam a 1:59.55 in the 200-yard IM.

Dougherty swims on the club level with the Patriot Aquatic Club.

Seebeck was spectacular at last year's Minnesota State Championships, winning the 100-yard freestyle title with a 46.14 and placing third in the 50-yard freestyle with a 21.04. Seebeck earned 2005 High School All-American honors in the 50 free, 100 free, and as part of the 200 and 400 freestyle relays while also earning consideration for the 2005 Minnesota Swimmer of the Year award.

Seebeck trains with Team Foxjet, the same club that produced current Flames swimmer [Jessica Darud](#). With Foxjet

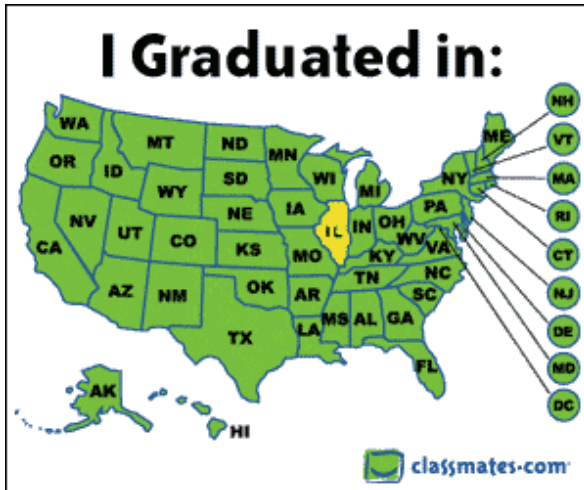
