### Soccer Hosts UW-Green Bay In Horizon League Championship Quarterfinal Saturday

Third-seeded Flames and sixth-seeded Phoenix clash at Flames Field at 1:00 p.m.

**Chicago, Ill.-** The 2005 Horizon League Men's Soccer Championships open today as third-seeded University of Illinois at Chicago hosts the University of Wisconsin-Green Bay at Flames Field beginning at 1:00 p.m. Central.

The Flames head into the match with a 10-4-2 overall mark and a 4-2-1 record in Horizon League action. UIC has won seven of their last nine games.

UW-Green Bay heads into today's contest with an 8-9-0 record and a 3-4-0 mark against Horizon League foes.

In their regular season meeting on October 22nd, [Pavle Dundjer](#) knocked in the golden goal in overtime to propel the Flames to a 2-1 win over the Phoenix.
