Eric Cervantes Named To College Soccer News National Team Of The Week

Five-point effort against Detroit this past Sunday earns senior forward national accolades.

Chicago, Ill.- Following a two-goal performance against Detroit this past Sunday, UIC senior forward [Eric Cervantes](#) (Hoffman Estates, Ill./Hoffman Estates H.S.) was named to College Soccer News National Team of the Week for the period ending Sept. 24th.

Cervantes opened the scoring against the Titans in the 20th minute, and after assisting on [Pavle Dundjer's](#) goal in the 81st minute he hit the back of the net for the second time in the 83rd minute to register his first career five-point performance in a match.

The fourth-year striker is now tied for the team lead in goals with four.

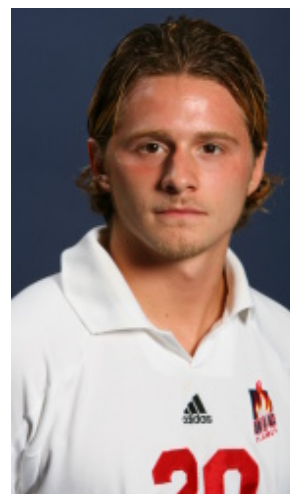
The honor marks the first time this season that a UIC player has been recognized on the College Soccer News National Team of the Week.

This is the third straight week that a UIC player has earned a spot on a national team of the week of any kind. Defensive standouts [Derek Kosek](#) (Sept. 11) and [Pat McMahon](#) (Sept. 18) earned spots on the College Team of the Week published by Top Drawer Soccer.
