UIC Men's Soccer Ranked Among Top 10 In Nation

Flames break through Top 10 in three national polls, earn top region ranking.

Sept. 19, 2006

Chicago, Ill.- The UIC men's soccer team continues its rise as one of the nation's best programs, earning the first Top 10 national ranking in school history while taking over sole possession of the No. 1 spot in the Great Lakes Region.

UIC is now ranked 8th in the SoccerTimes.com Top 25 Division I College Coaches Poll. The Flames also moved up to No. 9 in the NSCAA/adidas National Rankings and No. 10 in the Soccer America College Men's Top 25.

In the latest College Soccer News Top 30, the Flames moved up five spots to 14th.

On Tuesday the NSCAA/adidas Great Lakes Region Rankings were also released, and after sharing the top spot with both Indiana and Notre Dame last week, the Flames stood alone at No. 1 in the region.

UIC is now 6-0-2 after shutouts of Florida International and Florida Atlantic over the weekend. The Flames' eight-match unbeaten start to the season is the best beginning to a campaign in UIC history.

The Flames begin the Horizon League campaign on the road at Detroit this Sunday.
