- [Pat McMahon](#) picked up his first collegiate goal with his tally against Marquette.
- [Pavle Dundjer's](#) assist on McMahon's goal was Dundjer's first since October 16, 2005 against Butler. Dundjer had a team-leading eight assists that season; he went assist-less in 2006.
- Sunday's season opener against Marquette marked the second consecutive season that the Flames featured over 830 fans at Flames Field for the home opener. Last season UIC battled DePaul in front of 834, while the head count for this year's lidlifter was 835.
- Sunday's attendance is a school record for a UIC men's soccer home opener.
- Five freshmen made their collegiate debut in UIC's Starting XI on Sunday.
- UIC extended its streak of giving up no more than a goal in a game to 22 matches.
- UIC improves to 14-9-3 all-time in home openers.
- The Flames have not lost a home match since November 5, 2005, a streak spanning 11 home contests (8-0-3).
