Four UIC Student-Athletes Earn Academic All-Horizon League Recognition

Soccer's Tonci Skroce and Derek Kosek and Cross Country's Mikhail Davidyan and Lisa Petty receive Academic All-League honors.

Chicago, Ill.- University of Illinois at Chicago student-athletes [Tonci Skroce](#), [Derek Kosek](#), Mikhail Davidyan and Lisa Petty were selected to their respective Academic All-Horizon League teams, the league office announced on Thursday afternoon.

Skroce and Kosek were named to the Men's Soccer Academic All-League Team, while Davidyan and Petty earned a spot on the Men's and Women's Cross Country Academic All-League Teams, respectively.

An All-Horizon League First Teamer this past season with a team-leading eight goals, Skroce managed to post a 3.30 GPA as a marketing major.

Kosek, a third-year back who served as one of the team's captains this season, earned a 3.35 GPA majoring in pre-physical therapy.

The cross country program featured two repeat Academic All-League honorees in Davidyan and Petty, who were also selected to the 2004 teams.

Davidyan, an All-Horizon League Second Teamer who ran his way to a career year in 2005, accumulated a 3.75 GPA coming into his final campaign. The Academic All-League award for Davidyan in 2005 marked the third consecutive season that the Skokie, Ill., native was named to the Academic All-League Team.

Petty, one of the women's team's top runners and an active student who serves as secretary of UIC's Student Athlete Advisory Committee, earned a 3.81 GPA majoring in history teacher education.

Petty was the only undergraduate to repeat on the Academic All-Horizon League Team and joined two-time league champion Victoria Mitchell, a graduate student at Butler, as the only female cross country runners to earn a spot on the past two Academic All-League Teams.

The Horizon League honors student-athletes with Academic All-League teams in each of its 19 championship sports. To be eligible for Academic All-Horizon League consideration, a student-athlete must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.25 or higher (based on a 4.00 scale) and have completed at least one year at the member institution and earned 24 semester-hour or 36 quarter-hour credits.
