### Sixth-Ranked Soccer's Streak Halted At Nine Following 1-0 Loss At Wisconsin

Flames suffer first loss of the season on Thursday night.

**Madison, Wis.-** The sixth-ranked UIC soccer team's unbeaten start was halted at nine matches following a narrow 1-0 loss to host Wisconsin at the McClimon Soccer Complex on Thursday night.

The Flames (7-1-2), who wrapped up a six-game road swing, controlled possession most of the match but could not produce a quality shot against target.

Wisconsin (5-3-2) scored the only goal of the match after a free kick taken by Zack Lambo in the 19th minute was sent toward a scrum of players in the box. Eric Conklin emerged and headed in a ball past UIC keeper [Jovan Bubonja](#).

Bubonja did make six impressive saves on the evening.

"Teams are up for us," said UIC head coach [John Trask](#). "When you're up there ranked, it's a whole new ballgame.

"Ask [Wisconsin's] staff and they'll tell you that was probably as good as they played all year," Trask said of the Flames' opposition. "Too many off performances for us.

"As I told the players, I take some of the blame," said Trask. "It's my fault I didn't have them g'd up enough. Now it's time to see if their heads are right after this.

"What are we made of come Tuesday night? That is a very, very important game."




Jovan Bubonja made six saves against Wisconsin.
