### Dundjer, Zambrano Connect On Golden Goal In Soccer's 1-0 Win Over Valparaiso

Senior duo ends Senior Night with a double-overtime winner on Halloween.

**Chicago, Ill.-** Senior midfielders [Pavle Dundjer](#) and [Cesar Zambrano](#) were not about to let their night end on a sour note.

After getting recognized along with fellow soon-to-be graduating players [Brandon Bilbrey](#), [Jeff Engelbrecht](#) and [Pawel Ligas](#) as part of Senior Night festivities before Wednesday's match against Valparaiso, the duo ended the game on a golden goal connection with less than four minutes left in the second overtime session to send the UIC men's soccer team to a thrilling 1-0 victory at Flames Field.

In a bone-chilling Halloween affair with significant implications on seeding in the Horizon League Tournament, UIC (7-5-5, 3-1-3 Horizon League) dictated the pace of the match throughout but was unable to break through on the scoreboard.

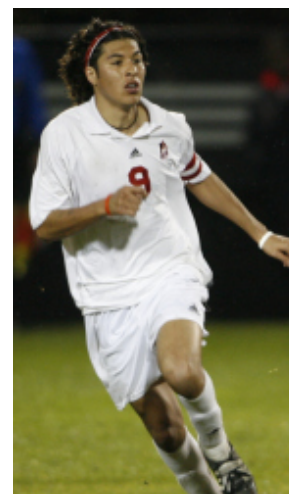
Facing a deflating draw that would knock the Flames out of contention for a third seed and a bye to the quarterfinals in the league tourney, the home side turned up the intensity as the clock wound down.

UIC earned a throw-in on the deep left side near the visitors' goal in the 107th minute, allowing [Mike Giffin](#) to toss in a fine ball into the possession of Zambrano in the box. The wily midfielder created space with a few dribble moves and lifted a nifty pass to a streaking Dundjer, who found open space and quickly sent in a shot that hugged net and sent Flames fans home happy.

The Flames outshot the Crusaders (3-10-3, 1-4-2 Horizon League) 11-1.
