

Wall Wins Three Event Titles For Men's Track & Field At Chicago Duals

Chicago, Ill. - Another weekend, another meet chalk full of personal best performances from Andy Wall as the junior highlighted an impressive showing by the UIC men's track and field team at the Chicago Duals hosted by the University of Chicago.

Wall, the two-time reigning Horizon League Track & Field Athlete of the Week, took top honors in the 55-meter hurdles (8.04), triple jump (14.40m) and high jump (2.02m) setting new personal high water marks in each event.

Wall wasn't the only event winner on Saturday, though, as senior Alex Sutphen crossed the line first in the 5,000-meter race in 15:18.83.

Freshman Matt Zuluckyj gave UIC a runner-up finish in the 800-meter race with a time of 1:58.16.

As far as team scoring was concerned, the Flames bested DePaul, Chicago State, Beloit, Elmhurst, Illinois Tech and MSOE in the dual scoring format, while coming in just behind the scores of North Central College and host Chicago.

The Flames will be back in action next weekend when they compete in the Illinois Wesleyan Invitational.
