Chicago, Ill. - The UIC softball team watched an early two-run lead evaporate on Sunday afternoon as Saint Louis rallied for a 3-2 victory at Flames Field in the finale of the UIC Round Robin.

The loss spoiled a three-hit effort from freshman Alicia Abbott. Shortstop Brooke Frydendall also had two hits in a losing effort for the Flames.

Junior Sarah Clynes went the distance for UIC in the circle, surrendering all three runs in the top of the third inning. Clynes settled down the rest of the way, allowing just two hits and fanning four over the final four frames.

UIC took a 2-0 lead in the bottom of the second inning on an RBI single by rookie Haley Brown and a run scoring fielder's choice off the bat of Nikki Rogers.

The Billikens came right back in the third with Nicki Jost knotting the score with a two-run homer to left. Annie Dillinger would drive home the game-winning run later in the inning with a two-out single to score Shana Richard.
