Chicago, Ill. - The 15th-ranked UIC men's soccer team takes to the road for their NCAA Tournament round of 32 match on Tuesday afternoon, where fourth-seeded Michigan State and the Flames will vie for a trip to the `Sweet 16' at DeMartin Stadium in East Lansing at 12 p.m. Central.

The Flames (12-3-5) reached the round of 32 for the fifth time in program history after advancing past Dayton in the opening tournament match on Friday night after a successful 3-1 penalty kick shootout over the Flyers.

Michigan State (13-5-1) received a first-round bye by virtue of winning the 2008 Big Ten Tournament with a 1-0 victory over Indiana Nov. 16. The Spartans also claimed the regular-season title after finishing the season with a 5-1-0 conference ledger.

Tuesday's matchup marks the second-consecutive season that the Flames will face a Big Ten foe on the road in the round of 32, as UIC defeated Northwestern 2-0 in Evanston en route to the Elite Eight in 2007.
